We'll try a little exercise called "Trampoline"

In order to do this, can you see ... I am raising my hand - my finger - with the arm. I'm moving my arm up and down ... and I'm relaxing my thumb ...

Let's talk about how we can change positions on the guitar, moving up and down the neck. Your arm is going to take your hand to a position. Just imagine that you are reaching up \dots , or giving someone a letter \dots , your arm is going to guide your hand. On the guitar it will look like this \dots

And now, we're going to play "Peter Gun"!

Open string, 2nd ... 3rd ... and 5rd frets
