Once your fingers can wrap around a chord, try the chord E-Major. You can make nice music by moving the chord up from the 1st to the 2nd, to the 4th fret and back.and you're playing Flamenco.

Let's go back to the right thumb to play the bass line as demonstrated. *Download the tablature. We can play *the E-Major chord in I and II positions to this.

And with the right hand fingers I am going to play *the melody, as demonstrated. \dots . See if you can tell which frets I am playing. To play this, you can either use the Free Stroke observe the ankered thumb and alternating fingers! \dots

... or you can move your hand slightly back and play from this knuckle, landing on the next string. This is called the Rest Stroke.
